

Forsbrook C. E (VC) Primary School

Forsbrook Primary school was formed in September 2000 from the amalgamation of The Beeches Junior School and Forsbrook C. E (VC) Infants School providing education from Reception to Year 6.

We are situated on the edge of the Staffordshire Moorlands and the southern end of Stoke on Trent serving the children of Forsbrook and Blythe Bridge and surrounding areas.

We share the same grounds as our local high school and so have extensive playing fields for our pupils to access and enjoy. Many sporting activities between the local schools are held on our playing fields, although this has been somewhat curtailed recently due to Covid restrictions. We retained the two school buildings which means we also have two halls providing us with lots of indoor space too.

Located within the old Infant building is our governor-managed Nursery & Out of School Club. We accept babies from 6 months old to pre-school in our nursery which is funded by pre-school grants and parental contributions. We pride ourselves on our amazing nursery which also has an Ofsted rating of 'outstanding'. Our Out of School Club is open from 7.30 am to 8.45 am and from 3.30 pm to 6 pm term time only.

Our school has a strong relationship with the local church of St Peter's enabling us to take the children into church for special acts of Collective Worship and curriculum enriching opportunities. We encourage our pupils and their families to attend Messy Church and other church events.

Our parents are very supportive, and we hold community events such as a Firework Display, Circus, Summer Fairs, Cream Teas to name a few.

Our children come to school happy and enjoy their learning; attendance and behaviour is very good. We have a dedicated and committed staff who encourage all our pupils to achieve the best they can.
